7. Whose family line was Jesus born in, many years later?

o Abram’s family line

8. What did God promise Abram?

o *Possible answers:* To take care of Abram, to bless Abram and his family, to make his family “more numerous than the stars,” etc.

9. What do you think peace means?

o *Possible answers:* Proving you care more about each other than winning an argument, showing you care by letting go of what’s fair, etc.

10. How can you make peace or show kindness this week? (Repeat this question, if needed.)

o Answers will vary.
