TODAY'S READING: John 17

God's glory is His attributes on display. The glory of God is His majesty and splendor. God is glorified when we respond to His glory by worshiping Him. God's glory is His goodness shown to us, and we glorify God when we celebrate Him for His glory! In John 17:1, Jesus asks the Father to glorify the Son. Jesus was praying for His own goodness to be worshiped. It is important to remember that Jesus is fully God and fully man. Although Jesus took on human flesh, He is 100% divine and worthy of glory and praise. We must remember that God is glorious even if no one is acknowledging it. God is worthy of praise because He is God, and we glorify Him when we respond to Him by worshiping him.

In verse 2, Jesus shows us He will give eternal life to those who believe in Him. Although Jesus is about to be cursed and rejected on the cross, verse 5 tells us He will be glorified with the Father as He was before the world existed! Jesus had been telling his disciples, "The hour has not yet come," for the last three years and now He is preparing to be crucified so He can receive glory and we can have eternal life. Jesus will be raised from the dead securing our eternal life! In verse 3, we see that eternity will be knowing God forever. We will have fellowship with the Creator of the universe where we get to live how we were created to live: celebrating the glory of God and finding joy in Him forever.

PRAYER: God, You are worthy of praise and all my worship. Thank You for securing my eternity with You through your son Jesus. Help me live today in a way that glorifies You.
