DAY 1

Read Ephesians 3:20

Think about your day yesterday.

Did you say something you wish you could take back?

Did you hurt someone else's feelings?

Did you lie so you wouldn't get in trouble?

Did you know that God NEVER does anything wrong? God never lies. God never does something unkind or hurtful. God is perfect.

We are far from perfect. But there is good news! Because God sent Jesus, there is a way for all those mess-ups—our sin—to be forgiven. When we trust Jesus as our Savior and choose to follow Him, we can have a relationship with God forever! We can have JOY because of Jesus.

Take a minute to tell God you're sorry for one of your mess-ups. Thank God for sending Jesus so you can be forgiven and ask for help to make a different choice next time.

DAY 2

Read Mark 10:27

Can you...

run from one end of a continent to another?

memorize the entire Bible?

go for a whole summer without any screen time?

be nice to your little sister or brother for a WHOLE month?

Some things seem impossible. Some things truly ARE impossible for us. But nothing is impossible for God. God can do anything. God loves you enough to send Jesus, to bring you JOY.

Read this verse out loud and thank God for being a great, big, loving God that you can always count on!

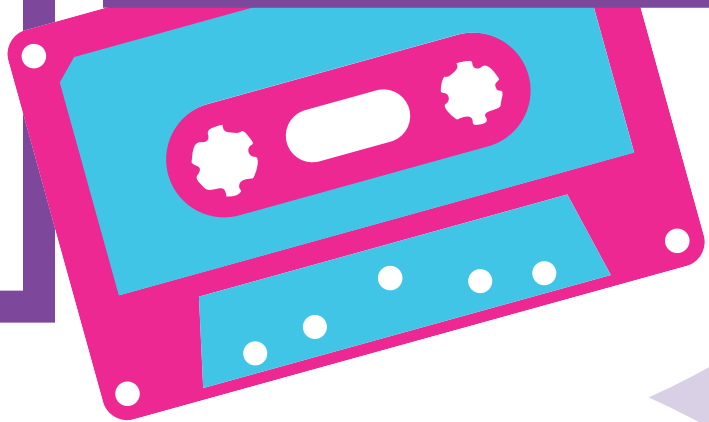
DAY 4

Three days later, He rose from the dead to prove that nothing could ever separate us again. Jesus came to live on earth so that He could rescue us. That's why we can have JOY!
