TODAY'S READING: Hebrews 4

As Christians, it is important to understand that the people of the Old Testament heard the good news and were called to respond in faith, just as we have heard the good news and have responded in faith. We cannot separate the Old and New Testament! The same God who promised a savior for His people is still in the business of saving today. God's promise to His people of eternal life is still offered to us today!

How can we have rest? How can we have eternal life? Just like in the Old Testament, we must have faith. This chapter reminds us that hearing the gospel and knowing God's promises on an intellectual level are not enough to save us; we must believe. We are reminded that God's Word is alive and exposes our sinful condition before a righteous and holy God. If we are Christ followers, we will strive to enter God's rest not to be saved, but because we are saved. We will be transformed and will look more like Christ by studying God's Word daily. We fail to enter God's rest because of our own disobedience, but thanks be to God that Jesus was tempted just as we are and did not sin! We can rest in what Christ did for us on the cross. When you have failed and are weary, draw near to the throne of grace and find mercy because of what Jesus has done for you.

PRAYER: Good and perfect God, thank You for giving me true rest when all I have done is disobey You. Thank You for giving me Your Word and sanctifying me by Your Spirit.
