TODAY'S READING: Hebrews 7

The Levitical priesthood was everything for the Jewish people. The priests represented the people before God and made sacrifices for sins on behalf of the people. The author of Hebrews reminds us in verse 11 that there was a need for more priests because the priesthood could not bring perfection. The priesthood brought with it the law. Under the law we are reminded that we cannot keep God's commandments perfectly. The author notes the "*change in the law*" in verse 12 to show that Christ is a better priesthood. Jesus, the non-Levitical High Priest brings a better, new covenant than the Mosaic covenant!
