Steps Toward Becoming a More Loving Person
1. Experience God's
"We love because he first loved us." (1 John 4:19)

"that you, being rooted and grounded in love, may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth, and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God." (Ephesians 3:17–19)

Unloved people are often unloving people

"My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you." John 15:12

2. Forgive
"bearing with one another and, if one has a complaint against another, forgiving each other; as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive." (Colossians 3:13)
We cannot give total love when our heart is divided
A that is not processed properly is still impacting the present
3. Think loving
"Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others." (Philippians 2:4)
We can choose to focus on other's needs, hurts problems, desires and goals; not just our own
<b>4</b> in love (Luke 6:27-28)
Three Actions Steps:
•: Serve them, help them, meet their needs
•: A positive word spoken about or to others
•: Pray for God's blessings in their lives
