## TODAY'S READING: Revelation 16

When you think about the many attributes of God, what comes to your mind? We think of God as loving, faithful, kind, powerful, glorious, etc. He is absolutely all of those things! There are other aspects of God that we do not talk about as much because they are less pleasant, such as His judgment and wrath. Wrath is not a common answer when we describe God. But it is important for us to consider.
