TODAY'S READING: Hebrews 10

Have you ever tried to do something alone--like working out, eating better, reading your Bible or something similar? It can be hard to continue to do these things on your own, because you have no accountability. No one likes accountability, but if we are honest, we are more likely to accomplish a goal if we have people cheering us on and giving us a push when we need it.

The same is true when it comes to faith. Being around the people of God helps us get closer to God. We do not have to struggle alone anymore. Connecting to a group of people following Jesus helps us learn who God is and how to take next steps with Him. Our faith is not to be lived out in isolation.
