READING: Revelation 22

The year was 1969. It was one of the harshest winters the United Kingdom had experienced. In a secluded country cabin, George Harrison penned the words to the song "Here Comes the Sun." Harrison's motivation for the song came from the harsh weather and his own personal struggles. Adam McDonald wrote, "In the intro to the song, George Harrison sings about the light that is coming across the world. The sun is the universal symbol of light. Light in its essence is the absence of darkness. All good in the world is represented with light and bad with darkness. Hence, the rising sun is a metaphor for something good happening or about to happen. And from what we have read, George Harrison could use some light in his life."¹

The song is over 50 years old and is still well known today. The imagery of better days ahead still resonates with audiences. As believers in Jesus Christ, we know this is especially true for us. Though the dark seems prevalent in our culture and the future on earth seems more and more bleak, we can have confidence because Jesus is triumphant.
