

## Water for My Camels

TODAY'S READING: Genesis 24

Genesis 24 is a passage woven with God's power and presence. We see that specific prayers bring about specific answers. The servant is given the very difficult task of finding Isaac's wife. Abraham has given him specific instructions which lead him to a very specific prayer. The servant must have been so excited to hear the woman offer water to his camels after his prayer. When we have challenges in our lives, are we praying specifically?

We also see in this passage the obedience of Rebekah. A normal day of getting water turns into a day that forever changed her life. Her response, leaving immediately for what God had for her, tells us about her heart. Like Rebekah, we need to be in a place where God can radically change our daily lives and we trust Him and follow His plans.

Our God is a God of details. Our God cares for His people, and He knows what is best for us. Rebekah's obedience to God's plan for her life, even though uncertain, should challenge us to be looking and listening for what God has for us. Pray specific, be ready.

**PRAYER:** Father, thank You for using Your people to fulfill Your will. May I be ready and willing for whatever You have for my life. May my prayers be specific, and genuine, when life's challenges come. Thank You, Father, for loving me, and caring about me.
