### How God Uses Problems in My Life

# 1. God uses problems to me

"And Joseph's master took him and put him into the prison, the place where the king's prisoners were confined, and he was there in prison. But the LORD was with Joseph and showed him steadfast love and gave him favor in the sight of the keeper of the prison." (Genesis 39:20–21)

"And there arose on that day a great persecution against the church in Jerusalem, and they were all scattered throughout the regions of Judea and Samaria. except the apostles." (Acts 8:1)

Ask: Where is this problem **Leading** me?

"And you shall remember the whole way that the LORD your God has led you these forty years in the wilderness, that he might humble you, testing you to know what was in your heart, whether you would keep his commandments or not." (Deuteronomy 8:2) "Count it all joy, my brothers, when you meet trials of various kinds, for you know that the testing of your faith produces steadfastness. And let steadfastness have its full effect, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing." (James 1:2-4) "Behold, I have refined you, but not as silver: I have tried you in the furnace of affliction." (Isaiah 48:10) Ask: What does this problem about me? 3. ### The next time you face a problem ask...

- Lord, are you using this problem to direct me? Where is this problem leading me?
- 2. Lord, are you using this problem to inspect me? What does this problem reveal about me?
- 3. Lord, are you using this problem to correct me? What is this problem teaching me?
- 4. Lord, are you using this problem to perfect me? How can I grow from this problem?

#### **Making It Personal**

- The greatest problem that any of us has is our separation from God because of our sin.
  The only solution is the perfect provision of Jesus Christ. Have I opened up my life to Jesus Christ as my only Savior and rightful Lord?
- What has been my pattern in responding to life's problems? What changes can I make in my response to better align myself with God's purposes?
- What problem is God currently using in my life? What are the questions I need to be asking about this problem?
- Who can I share these truths with?
