



The Woman, the Dragon and the Child

READING: Revelation 12

Our reading unfolds with two distinct visions. The first vision is a pregnant woman in Heaven. On her head are 12 stars. The woman in the passage represents the nation of Israel. The 12 stars represent the 12 tribes of Israel. Then, on the scene, we see a great red dragon. This dragon has 7 heads and 10 horns. These components represent the dragon's governmental operations, the 10 horns represent the 10 kings of the world. When the woman gave birth to the promised Messiah, the One who would rule the nation, the dragon was standing by to devour. However, the Child was saved.

"She bore a male Child who was to rule all nations with a rod of iron. And her Child was caught up to God and His throne. Then the woman fled into the wilderness, where she has a place prepared by God, that they should feed her there one thousand two hundred and sixty days" (Revelation 12:5,6 NKJV).

This, my friends, reflects the midpoint of the great tribulation. The nation of Israel has been protected by God for the last three and a half years. However, the fight is far from over. The next vision that John is shown is the battle of Michael and his angels against the dragon. There are so many people that have theorized about when this battle took place.
