Prayer Walking Do's and Don'ts

HERE'S OUR VISION: To see Christ become the hub of every home in our community and beyond. It's a big vision, but we serve a big God. We believe that God will greatly use our efforts for His glory. And it all starts with prayer. We don't want to even attempt to see Christ become the hub of every home without the empowerment of the Holy Spirit. And that's why we begin with prayer. As we pray, here's a few reminders about what to do and what not to do.



- Do walk. As you go, use sidewalks and driveways. Don't walk through yards.
- Do pray. Your prayer will be repeated and brief, but it will be impactful. You
 can simply pray, "God, please open up doors so that Christ will become the
 hub of this home. Amen."
- **Have fun.** This is a tremendous opportunity. Enjoy it. Let joy fill your heart as you go.



- Don't knock. At no point, knock or ring a doorbell.
- **Don't talk.** Pray & Go is designed for prayer. The idea is not to spend time talking, but at the same time, don't be rude. If you happen to engage with someone, let them know you are praying for our community. Hand them a doorhanger if they will accept it.
- Don't go alone. Always walk in pairs.
- **Don't go near kids or pets.** If there are kids or pets visible, do not place the doorhanger. Pray for the house, but keep walking to the next house.
- Don't stop. Don't stop in front of a house and prayer or talk. Keep moving.
 Your prayer will be brief. Pray as you walk in front and as you place the doorhanger.

Thank you for your willingness to pray. Thank you for your heart to see Christ become the hub of every home. Let's attempt great things for God!
