Be Certain

TODAY'S READING: Revelation 11

Before I start, I recommend getting an ESV study Bible and checking out the commentary series, "Christ – Centered Exposition." Commentary is always helpful when studying the Bible, especially when studying Revelation. Eschatology is theology that deals with the last things (end times), and although believers may disagree on which view is correct, (Amillennialism, Postmillennialism, Historic Premillennialism, and Dispensational Premillennialism) we all agree that Christ will return one day!

I want us to focus on Revelation 11:15-19. This chapter is the fulfillment of Psalm 2, and it is Matthew 6:10 realized. I encourage you to read these passages of scripture after reading Revelation 11. We are used to praying, "Your kingdom come" and in Revelation 11, it is here!

There a lot of things in life that we are uncertain of. We do not know which political party will control our country in the future, we do not know how our 401K will do, and we do not know how long we have left to live. In the midst of uncertainty, it is easy to become worried and anxious about the future. Revelation 11 reminds us that there are things we can be absolutely certain about: When Christ returns He will be worshiped, He will judge everyone, His servants will be rewarded, and He will pour out his wrath on those who destroy the earth.

"Destroyers of the earth" does not refer to people who do not recycle. It refers to those who pollute the earth with their sin. When you wonder how long people will be allowed to do evil, remember Revelation 11:18, "the nations raged, but your wrath came." Christian, you are God's servant and the uncertainty of life pales in comparison to worshiping our God for all eternity. Be certain that you have thanked God today.

PRAYER: God, You are worthy to be worshiped. Thank You for pouring out Your wrath on Your Son instead of me. Help me be Your faithful servant today and give me eyes to see those who remain under Your wrath so I can point them to You.
