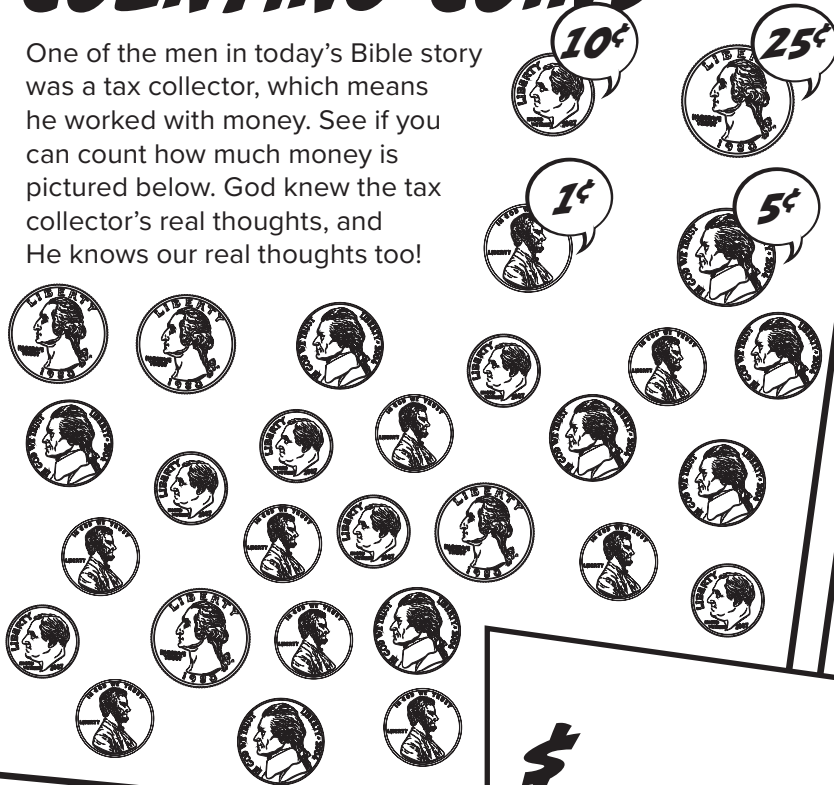

## COUNTING COINS

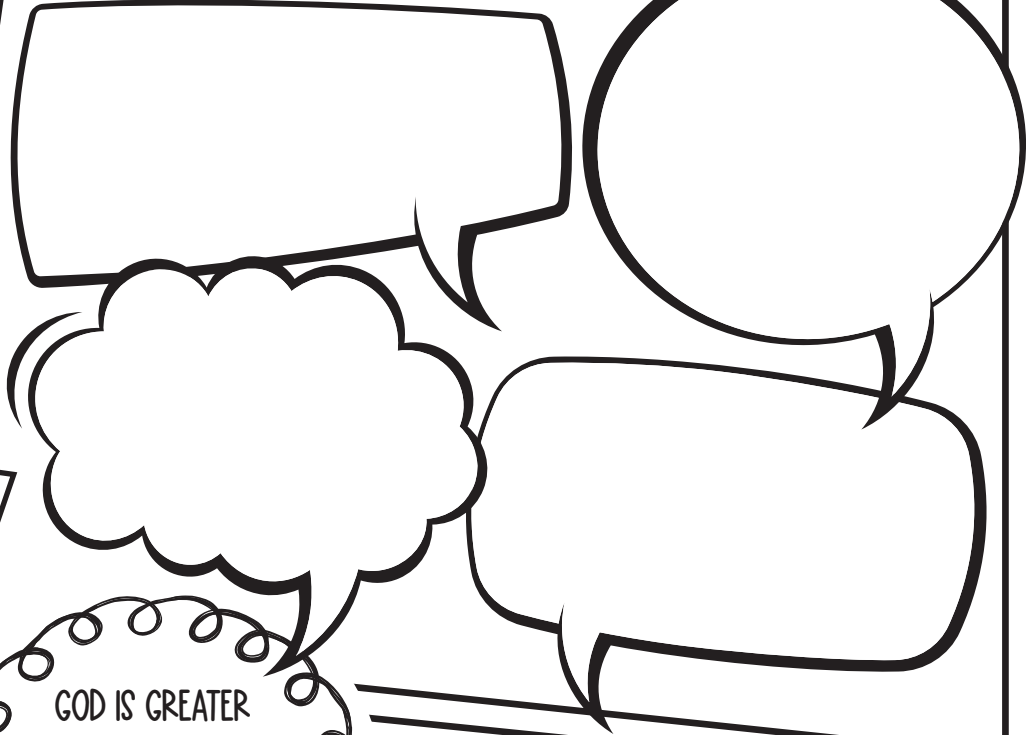
