FLIP TO FLOAT EXAMPLE

- **1:** Fold a piece of copy paper in half four times—twice vertically and twice horizontally. Unfold the paper to reveal 16 rectangles.
- **2:** Draw the Bible story on the 16 rectangles, keeping the background images in same place for all 16 panels.
- **3:** Cut along the lines, resulting in 16 individual rectangles.
- **4:** Put the rectangles in order. Staple the book closed on the left-hand side.
- 5: Flip through the book quickly to see the story "move."
