Cost: Just for FBCG-

- Canoes are **\$15 per person.**
- **Kayaks \$20 per person**
- Bring your own canoe or kayak it is a \$20 fee to transport to drop point.
- Camping information is available on their website.

Route:

- Bogue Chitto River – 11-mile float/paddle 4-5 hours (wider route, usually more current, open areas that require paddling, have to avoid logs and choose a run path)

What to Bring:

- Fluids (group up with ice chest) & snacks/food
- Sunscreen
- Must wear shoes on creek or river!!!! (do not want cut feet)
- Sunshades & hat
- Change of clothes for trip home (showers & bathrooms at the outpost)
- Rope/cord to tie gear to canoe/kayak – some of you will flip
- A good attitude and communication skills! Screaming “go that way” is not communicating a direction with a good attitude!

General Rules:

- Pray before we start the trip & safety precautions
- Wear sunscreen and shoes!
- Stay hydrated
- Avoid going into low lying tree limbs if possible (wasp nest, drop fishing lines with hooks, snakes)
- Give safe distance between canoes in tight run routes – if you jam up around a tight route – someone flips
- Always keep the canoe behind you in sight – it keeps us from spreading out too far and allows for assistance
- Always help another if one flips or gets jammed in the logs
- No glass containers on the river/creek
