Celebrate Our Risen Lord!

I would like to begin by thanking all of you for participating in our **Annie Armstrong Easter Offerings**. We beat our goal and raised over \$1,160 for North American Missions! God bless each one of you who gave.

This year, **Palm Sunday**, **Good Friday** and **Easter Sunday** all take place at the beginning of April. This is a very special time of the year. We need to invite our families and friends to join us in our celebrations!

On **Palm Sunday** we will have our regular schedule, but our worship will emphasize the theme of that first **Palm Sunday**. On that afternoon at 2pm, we will bring a service to the San Luis Care Home here in Newman. Our services there have been on hold since the Pandemic, but we have been invited by the residents to come back! Please let me know if you are interested in participating in this ministry. On Sunday night at 6pm we will continue our study of Hebrews.

On **Good Friday** at 6pm we will meet in the Sanctuary to sing together about the cross and hear a message from Psalm 22.

On **Easter Sunday** we will join with two other churches to host a 7am Sunrise Service in Sherman Park. Orestimba Presbyterian Church will lead the singing and I will preach a short message. We will also decorate the cross with flowers to symbolize that life came out of death.

We will celebrate our Risen Lord during our regular Sunday School and Worship service times in the morning, but we will not meet that evening.

On April 16th, I will begin a new series of AM messages on Paul's letter to the Philippians, "**Living Above Our Circumstances**." I will continue my series on the book of Hebrews "**Put Your Confidence in Christ**" in our evening Bible studies.

On April 23rd, we will have a Potluck lunch after our AM service. This is a great time of fellowship. We will have our quarterly Family Meeting on April 26th at 6pm. If you are a member of this Church Family, we would love to see you there.
