Easter is a special time of the year. While we celebrate Jesus' resurrection every week when we come together on Sunday morning, it is special to celebrate the resurrection every year as well. The resurrection is the foundation of our faith.

This year we will celebrate by having a Good Friday Service on April 3 @ 6pm. We will meet in our sanctuary, sing about the cross and I will share from the first part of Psalm 22. A few days later we will have a Sunrise Service in Sherman Park at 7am. Come and decorate the cross with flowers, sing songs about the resurrection and hear a message from Matthew 28.

On Easter Sunday we will **not** have our regular Adult Sunday School class. Instead, we will have a Continental breakfast in the fellowship hall. Everyone is welcome to come and share the joy of being together on Easter Sunday! After the breakfast we will have a special Easter Worship Service at 11am. We will sing about the resurrection and we will hear the second part of a message from Psalm 22. There will be no evening service on Easter Sunday.

The next three Sundays in April we will go back to our regular study in Acts. We will study chapters 16 and 17. On Sunday nights we will continue our walk through the Psalms. We will focus on Psalms 37, 38 and 39.

We will have an important Quarterly Family Meeting on April 29 at 6pm. Several elections will take place for the ministry of our church. We want to have your input.
