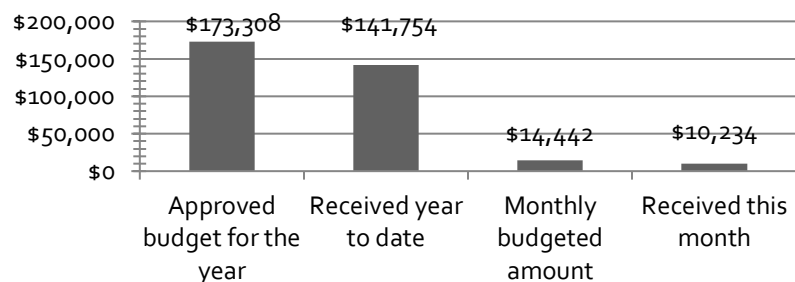


October 2022 Giving

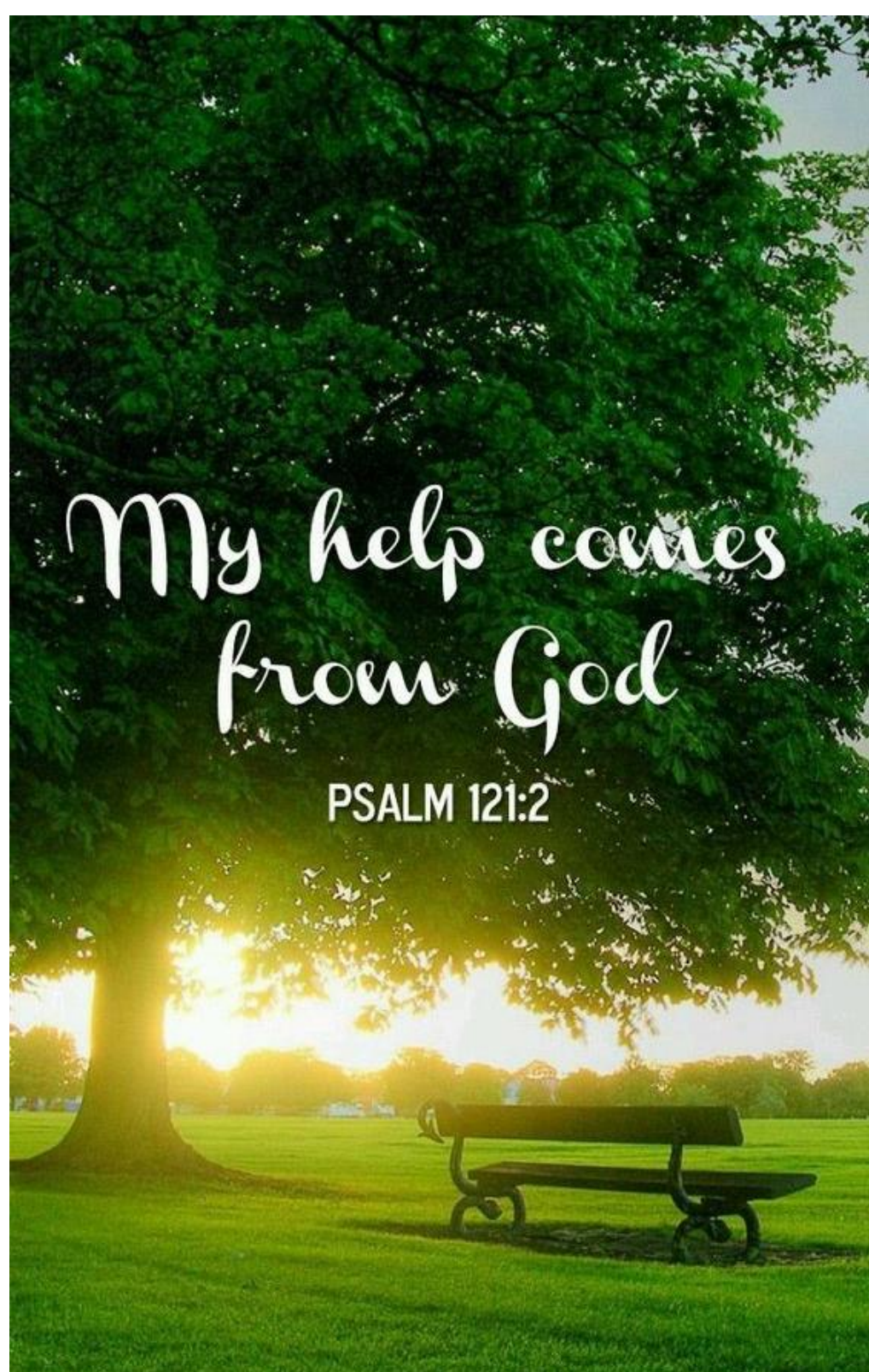
