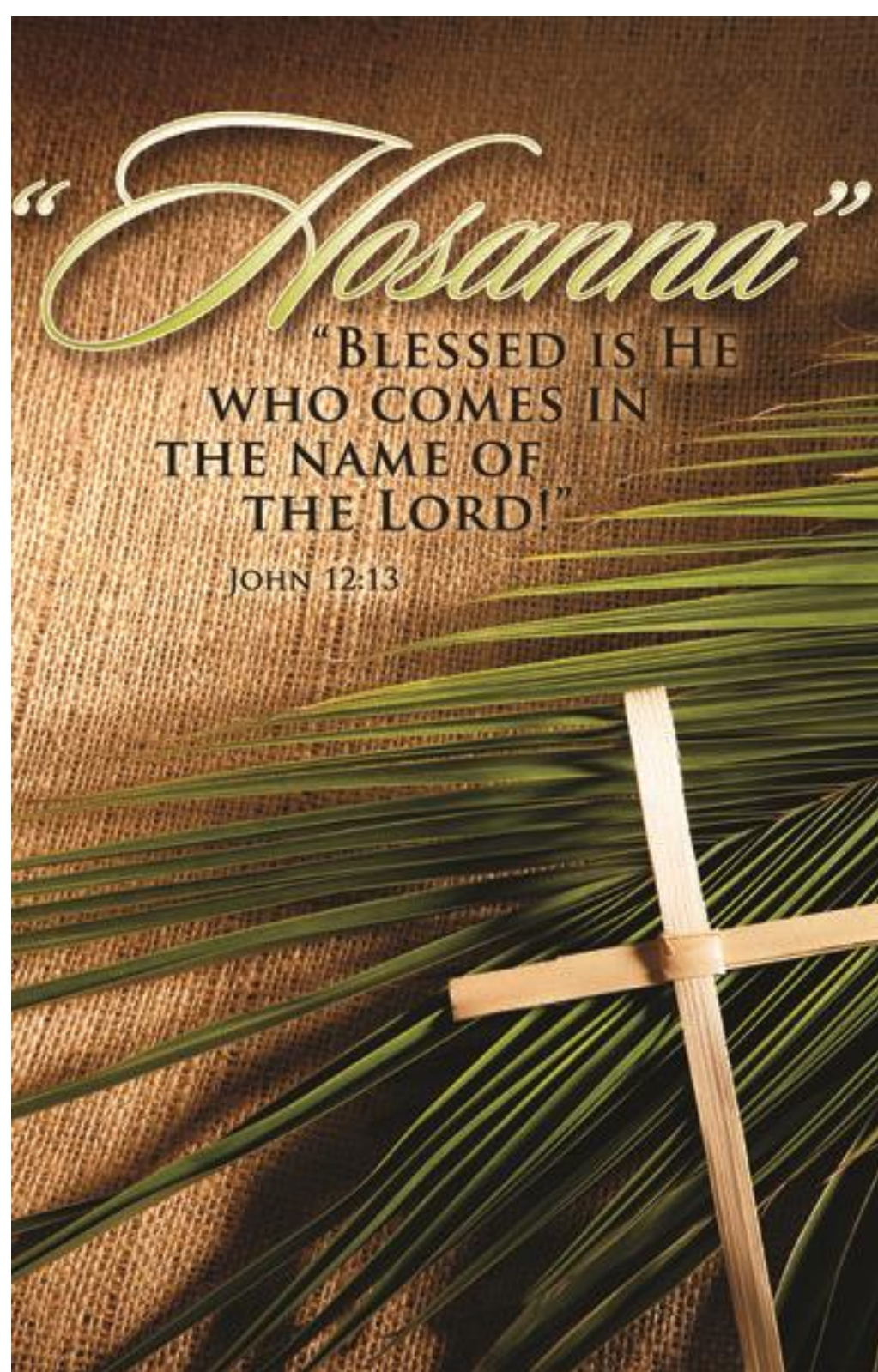
NOMINATING COMMITTEE REQUEST:
