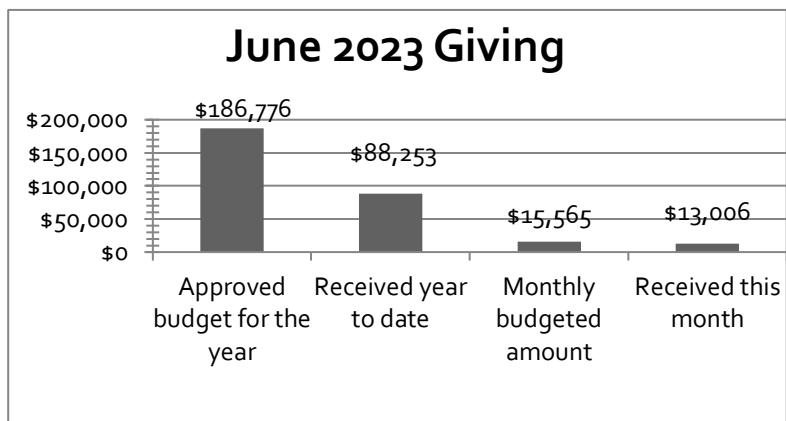

NOMINATING COMMITTEE REQUEST:

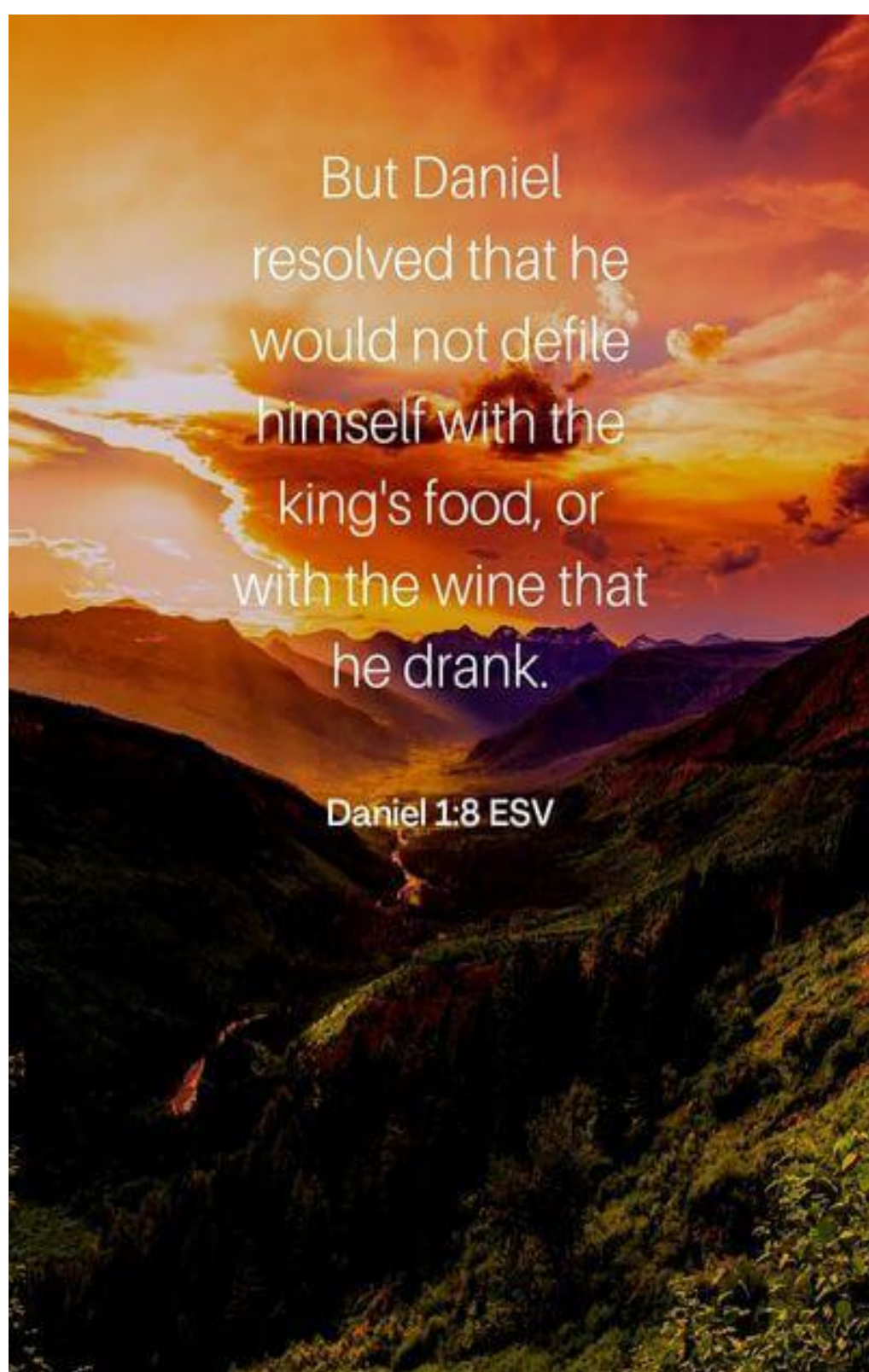
