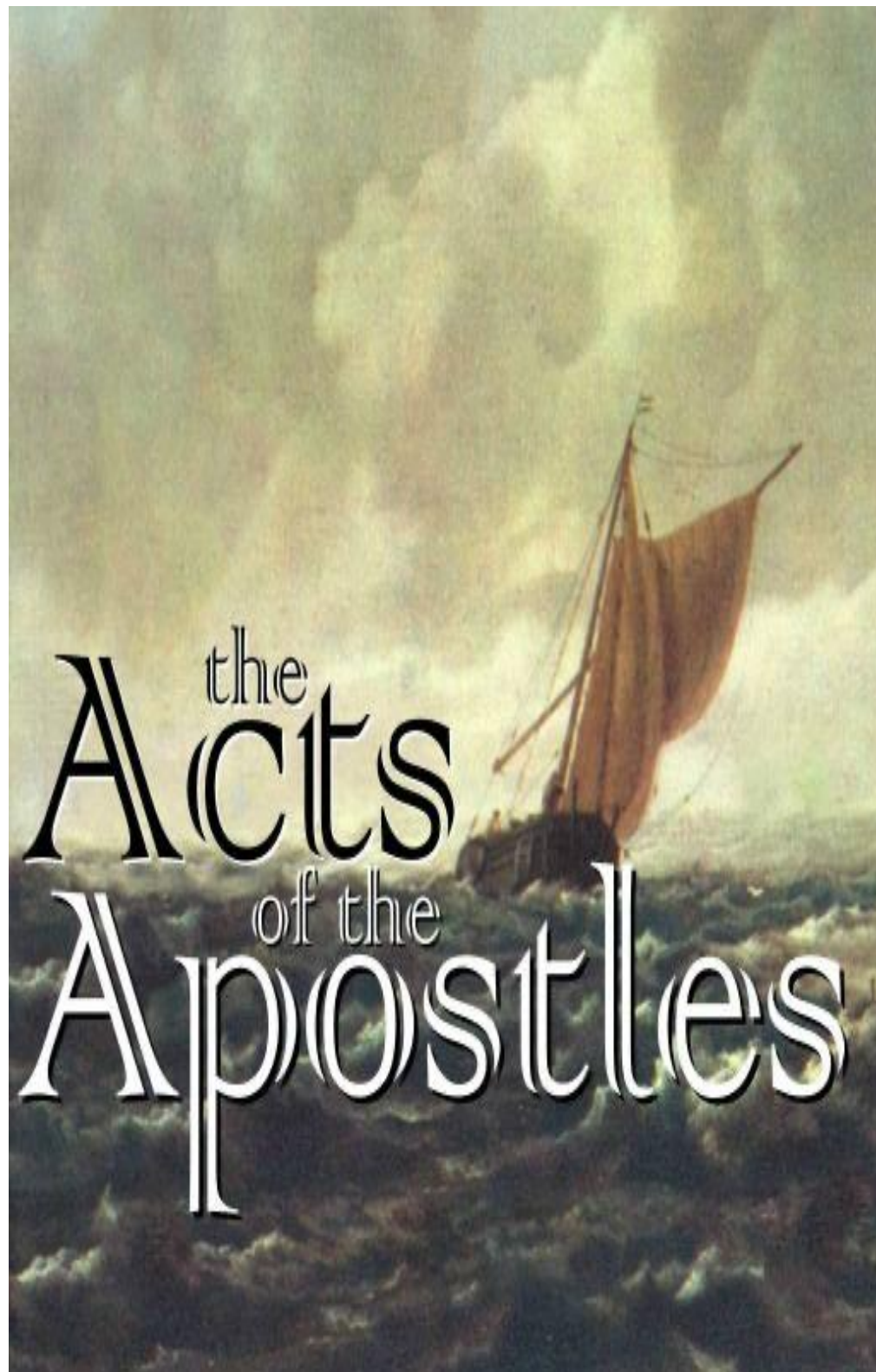
God Loves a Cheerful Giver:
