Celebrating Advent and Christmas!

Advent means coming. The people of Israel anticipated the coming of their Messiah. John the Baptist told them that they needed to prepare for His coming. But when Jesus came, few celebrated his arrival. The angels appeared to the shepherds in the fields. They came to celebrate and then they went out to proclaim the Good News. Anticipation, Preparation, Celebration, and Proclamation, these are **Appropriate Attitudes for Advent**. These attitudes will be our theme each Sunday morning before Christmas. We will be lighting a candle on **the Advent Wreath** each week to show us how close we are to Christmas. Each candle will have a symbolic significance. On **Christmas Eve** at 6pm, we will light the “Christ” Candle to symbolize His birth. We will also be highlighting the work of our Missionaries around the World with what we call **the Lottie Moon Christmas offering**. This is a special offering above our regular giving for the work of International Missions.

On Sunday evenings we will continue our journey through the Psalms. We will study Psalms 25 through 28 in December. We already have a good group coming to this service but we would be glad to have others join us or watch it online.

On the last Sunday morning of December, I am planning to return to our study of the Book of Acts. We plan to be in Acts until August of 2026.
