The South Asian Social at Sac State connected many students from India with local Christians from India. (Can you see me - the only white guy - in the photo?).



Also, we did “mobile mapping” at Sac City College and UC Davis. Van, our intern, and I made the Sac City College Facebook page doing mobile mapping. Our group will do mobile mapping next week at American River College and Sierra College too. Mobile mapping involves walking around campus and asking students to put a sticky dot on their home town. If they put the dot on somewhere outside of the USA we explain about our group and invite them to come to our activities. When we did mobile mapping at Sac City College, we invited several students to come to our weekly Talk Time activity (free pizza and conversation) and two or three new students have been coming each week! After Talk Time at Sac City we have Bible Discussion and this week three non-Christians stayed for Bible Discussion. We have also had two well attended International Student Dinners in Sacramento where students heard salvation testimonies from international student leaders. Praise God with us for all these outreach opportunities!

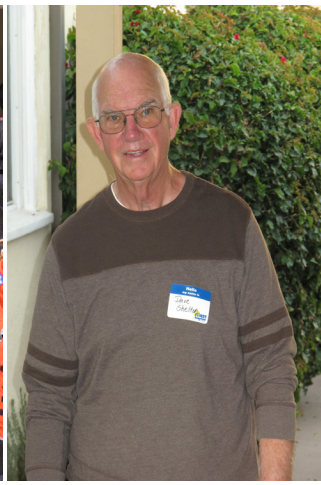

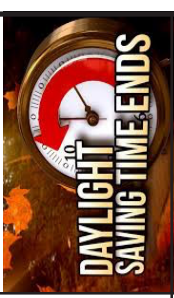
