#### "Time and Obedience: Essential Ingredients"

I recently started reading and working through Kenneth Boa's book, "Conformed to His Image", with friends and co-laborers in Christ. This is the third time I have gone through this book and each time I have been greatly impacted and challenged to love God more completely.

In the latest chapter I read, Boa writes:

In the last few years I have adapted and used this prayer by St. Richard of Chichester (1197-1253) in my own quiet time before the Lord: "Thanks be to thee, O Lord Jesus Christ, for all the benefits which thou hast given us, for all the pains and insults which thou hast borne for us. O most merciful Redeemer, Friend, and Brother, may we know thee more clearly, love thee more dearly, and follow thee more nearly; for thine own sake."

Loving God completely involves our whole personality: our intellect, emotion, and will. "And you shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind and with all your strength" (Mark 12:30). The better we come to know God ("may we know thee more clearly"), the more we will love Him ("love thee more dearly"). And the more we love Him, the greater our willingness to trust and obey Him in the things He calls us to do ("follow thee more nearly").

The great prayers in Ephesians 1 and 3, Philippians 1, and Colossians 1 reveal that

Paul's deepest desire for his readers was that they grow in the knowledge of Jesus Christ. The knowledge the apostle had in mind was not merely propositional but personal. He prayed that the Lord would give them a spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him, that the eyes of their hearts would be enlightened, and that they would know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge (Ephesians 1:17-18; 3:19)

What does it take to know God more clearly, to love Him more dearly and follow Him more nearly? The two essential ingredients are time and obedience. It takes time to cultivate a relationship and unless we set aside consistent time for disciplines such as solitude, silence, prayer and the reading of Scripture we will never become intimate with our Lord. To know God is to love Him, because the more we grasp - not merely in our minds but also in our experience - who He is and what He has done for us, the more our hearts will respond in love and gratitude.

So what are you willing to do in order to know God more clearly, love Him more dearly and follow Him more nearly? Are you willing to make being with Jesus the number one priority in your life?

Last year I made a decision to set aside additional time each day not only to reflect on the nature and person of God, but also to simply be with Him. As I did that I discovered that my devotional time became deeper and

richer. You know it really is an incredible experience to just quietly sit in the Lord's presence and to think about Him! Have you ever done that? If so, you know what it is that I am talking about! If not, I encourage you to try it! It really isn't difficult to mediate on the nature of God or to just think about who and what He is, but it surely is rewarding, because as you do that you will grow in your knowledge, love and willingness to follow the Lord our God! Moreover, it is something that God truly longs for you to do!

Although God is beyond anything I could ever imagine or dream and I cannot know all there is to know about Him, nonetheless, I have discovered as I simply spend time in His presence ... I am greatly moved by what I do know about Him! Folks, our God is AWESOME and He reigns and He loves us so very much!


Today as I spent time thinking about God and what He is like I was struck by the Apostle John's experience with Jesus. John, "the disciple that Jesus loved", had a very unique and special relationship with Him. And as I thought about this relationship and how close they were, my thoughts went to the last supper and how John leaned on Jesus' breast and spoke privately to Him. It's very apparent that John knew and loved Jesus! In fact, you could say that He was intimately familiar with Him. John even had the privilege of seeing Jesus during the transfiguration, which must

have been incredible! Yet, when John saw the glorified Jesus, he was totally overwhelmed by His appearance. Listen to how John himself describes it in Revelation, Chapter One: "And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet as a dead man." Revelation 1:17

Now think about this for a moment, John, who had spent more than three years with Jesus and knew Him intimately, was completely blown away when he saw Jesus as He truly was. The truth is that Jesus was not only beyond His comprehension but He was also beyond his ability to imagine. I have no words to describe how moved I was as I simply contemplated the description of Jesus that we find in the first chapter of the book of Revelation:

Now I don't know about you, but it is clear to me that I need to spend quality time each and every day thinking about the One I love and long to see! I encourage you to make spending time in the presence of God a priority in your daily life! How desperately we need to know Him more fully and see Him more clearly so that we may follow Him more nearly!

A few weeks ago, we took a small; group of our youth on one of the most amazing and beautiful places in the world. It's so incredible that Yosemite National Park is only a couple hours' drive away and many of our kids had never

been there before, or had seen it the way God had us experience it. I was so excited to take our kids on a new adventure, see their faces as we stood at the end of that amazing valley and looked at the 3,000 ft. granite cliffs and the 1,000+ ft. waterfalls. 

We thank Him and praise Him for His amazing power and creativity, and we are excited to see how He will connect the lessons we learned to our everyday lives here in San Mateo with Him.








