
FCF is a Reconciling Church- that celebrates and applies the reconciling work of Jesus Christ among the diverse cultures of Baltimore

Deadliest year in Baltimore history ends with 344 homicides

Blood was shed in Baltimore at an unprecedented pace in 2015, with mostly young, black men shot to death in a near-daily crush of violence. On a per-capita basis, the year was the deadliest ever in the city.



The Investment in Sandtown-Winchester

Despite at least \$130 million in public and private investment over the last 25 years, Baltimore's Sandtown-Winchester neighborhood is plagued by unemployment, poverty and blight. Here is a breakdown of the investment, and how the neighborhood – once a thriving middle-class African-American community – has changed in the last quarter century.


Joy is seeing the church loving our neighbors, caring for the downcast, providing and caring for people in Pen Lucy in the time of need.


