Pastoral Expectations

- Meeting the qualifications outlined in Timothy and Titus
- Striving to exemplify Christ Jesus in all facets of life
- Spending time daily in prayer and in God's Word
- Oversight of Hope Baptist Church, in consultation with the Deacon's Board
- Preaching a 30-40 minute sermon each Sunday morning
- Preparing a 10-20 minute prayer meeting lesson each Wednesday night
- Rotationally teaching an Adult Sunday School class with other men from the church
- Leading services occasionally
- To be present at and available to help with youth ministries (King's Club and Young People's)
- Basic care and maintenance of the parsonage and the property (lawn care, house cleaning, etc.)
- Visitation of church members and, to a lesser extent, those in the community
- Becoming a church member
- Planning and leading deacons' meetings
- Willingness to help out around the church in a variety of ways (participating in cleaning days, turning on heat, unlocking church for workers coming in, etc.)
- Desiring and working towards seeing unbelievers saved and believers growing
- Willingness to be here for special occasions (Christmas, Thanksgiving, Easter, etc.)

- Work travel allowance (\$65/month)
- House provided and upkeep costs paid
- Electricity and landline paid
- Firewood provided
- Snow removal provided
- 4 weeks paid vacation
