### ACTS 4

**Humble Witnesses:** I \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ the gospel boldly and with love.

#### A Humble Witness

- Looks for \_\_\_\_\_ to share the good news about Jesus (vv. 2, 7).
