## THE MARRIAGE OF HEAVEN & EARTH REVELATION 21-22

Nothing will threaten our \_\_\_\_\_ of God's presence or separate us from his love (21:1-8).

- From the very beginning to the very end, God's purpose and desire was to \_\_\_\_\_ (Genesis 3:8; John 1:14; Revelation 21:3).
