

# PRESCHOOL

As 2022 began, I entered my sixth month as Interim Director of Children and Preschool, under the leadership of our newly hired lead pastor – Pastor Drew Heurion. Our children and preschool ministry had experienced many changes in the previous five years with turnovers in our director and paid worker positions, our volunteer structures, and especially through Covid. We had no infant nursery, no crawler room, and combined toddler, 2-year-old and 3-year-old classes. The average children and preschool Sunday attendance was 45-50 children and Wednesday attendance was 25-30. Those numbers grew quickly and continue to grow. We have reopened an infant nursery with a current average of 5 babies (and more on the way). Volunteer teachers signed on and created separate classrooms for 2- and 3-year-olds, with an average of seven children each. We are currently in the process of opening a crawler room, allowing nursery space for those new babies, and providing the others a developmentally appropriate environment. We were blessed to hold several events for our children and preteens, with the support of so many church family members, including VBS (with 160 children and 98 adults and youth serving). And, especially praises for the six children who professed their acceptance of Jesus as Lord and Savior through Baptism.

One of the blessings during these challenges and growth is that the church voted in August to split the position of Children and Preschool Director, hiring a full-time Children's Director for our Kindergarten through Preteens and a part-time Preschool Director to manage birth through 4-year old's and supervise our paid childcare staff. In August we welcomed Travis Rhodes as our Children's Director! And I am so thankful to remain as the Preschool Director!

I am positive that God has been at work in our church. I have seen it in the resources He provided every step of the way – every volunteer, every dollar that has been contributed, every event that has exposed others to Jesus – all the love that Five Points shows as we truly treasure Jesus together! Please pray as we move forward to all God has in store for 2023.






