
WEDNESDAYS BACK IN ACTION!

COUNCIL REPORT FROM JANUARY 9, 2022

New members of this year's Council are David Mullins, Nathan Norris, and Peggy Ratcliff.

At our last meeting we discussed the budget for 2022. Our 2021 budget was \$623,813. Unfortunately, we did not bring in this amount of money. Our 2022 budget will be based on what we actually did bring in which was \$563,484. It is the goal of the Pastors and the Council that we be financially responsible for spending wisely on behalf of the Congregation.

On a bright note we learned the we have received a financial gift (\$350,000) from the Bob and Amanda Grant family who were former members of this Congregation. The money is being used to replace the emergency fund that was depleted by Hurricane Sally repairs, to put aside a reserve for emergency repairs, and to complete the Sanctuary remodel by purchasing the new piano and ordering a cross for the pulpit area.


