SANCTUARY REMODEL PROJECT ON THE HOMESTRETCH!

Pentecost Sunday was a wonderful day for Foley United Methodist Church. The church family acted in great unity through the sanctuary offering, celebrated God's faithfulness through the last five years of revitalization and stepped confidently into God's future for the church! To complete all the work inside the sanctuary, we needed approximately \$50,000. We have now received more than \$55,000! This generosity allowed the Church Council to approve the final work to be done in the sanctuary. As soon as this work is completed, we will move the 8:00 and 11:00 services back to the sanctuary. Hopefully, this will be by the end of this month or early next month.

To finish all the extras and things outside of the sanctuary room (new piano, new hymnals and Bibles, new furnishings for narthex and new Connection Room off the narthex, pedestal for bell, new sign, etc.), we needed an additional \$20,000 beyond the \$50,000 mentioned above. On Pentecost Sunday, we learned of an estate gift that the church will receive this fall. This gift will provide the balance of funds to finish everything else related to the sanctuary renovation project. As soon as the gift arrives, Church Council will approve the remaining work and finish the project.

Your commitment and participation in finishing the sanctuary project is a great investment in the future of Foley UMC. While we all enjoy returning to the familiar place we know for worship, the refurbished sanctuary will be a wonderful modern traditional worship space for a whole new generation of people to encounter the Lord in powerful ways. Thank you for helping create space for God to work through your generosity!

They serve families of all ages with youth programs, ASAP for older program adults, a food pantry

and a resale store. They are very proud of the Sybil Smith Family Village housing 17 families of women who have for some reason lost their home. The families live there until the mother has found a job and has saved the money to get into an apartment or house where they can restart their independent life. The Ruth Circle collects bathroom items for the Sybil Smith Family village to help refurnish an apartment as one family leaves and another moves in. DISCIPLESHIP UPDATES

The Discipleship Missional Community has been meeting for several months in response to the churchwide survey and prayer retreat in 2020 identifying discipleship as the number one area of focus that we believe God is calling us to at Foley UMC. We want to share with you a few thoughts that have emerged as we have met:

- Our understanding of discipleship can be summarized as "becoming more like Jesus and encouraging others to become more like Jesus".
- We firmly believe that if transformational discipleship is a priority at Foley UMC, we will see the other missional communities grow and flourish as a result of transformed lives.
- Our five year goal is to expand our community of Spirit-led disciples who join God on His mission of ongoing spiritual transformation.
- In order to foster a culture of discipleship at Foley UMC and in our community, we need you! We want everyone (literally everyone!) to be a Spirit-led disciple and we need leaders and facilitators to help make that happen.

Our goal is to introduce some opportunities and resources this fall and some in January. We have a tentative five year plan that includes opportunities for transformational discipleship for all:

- those who have never been part of the church and have questions
- new Christians wanting to grow and understand what it means to be a follower of Jesus
- those who have been deeply immersed in discipleship for many years

Our plan includes opportunities for children, youth, and adults and for those both inside and outside of the church. This is a monumental task and will only be possible with your involvement and willingness to serve. Training will be provided in any circumstance that it is needed.


The survey does not obligate you, but it provides the Discipleship Missional Community with information to begin putting together an array of opportunities for our church and community.



We are thankful for the Kids Missional Community and volunteers who loved children of Foley at Vacation Bible School at Heritage Park in June.


We had around forty kids registered for our Discovery on Adventure Island VBS!
