#### WHAT ARE THE FOUR PILLARS OF FOLEY UMC AND WHERE DID THEY COME FROM?

Back at the end of 2017, our Church Council began the work of trying to move toward a healthier future for the church. In January 2019, they began a nine-month research project into the current reality of the church and the community. The group was asked to find out what we as a congregation were, or were not doing in the name of missions, and what the needs of our community might be.

In February of 2020, a group of 35 members from Foley UMC spent 24 hours praying and discerning where God was leading our church for the 21st century. Out of this retreat came four areas of focus for missional work which we call our four pillars.



Kids Missional Community – From snacks for kids, to afterschool programs where meals were served, to developing a children's ministry that engages kids of all races, socioeconomic, and family backgrounds, the call to serve the children was unanimous.



Table Missional Community - Launching or partnering with a food pantry and using our facilities to prepare and serve meals to the community, collecting and donating snacks to the schools, the possibilities of serving through food are endless.



Real Life Needs Missional Community – Working with Family Promise, Hosting work teams after disasters and helping with disaster recovery, and more were all some of the ways that we could make a real difference for someone.



Discipleship Missional Community - At the core of everything we feel called to do is Jesus. We serve because he calls us to serve, and we serve because we want other people to experience the life-changing love of God.




