#### "DISCOVERING CHRISTMAS"

Every year it seems there is a lament about how early Christmas music starts or stores put out the "Christmas stuff". And it seems ironically every year Christmas gets buried more and more under the stuff of our culture because candidly, our culture is more and more hostile to what Christmas really means. Our economy would virtually collapse without what Christmas has become and yet the central meaning of Christmas is pushed more and more aside, if not denied all together.



This year I want to discover Christmas

again. And I hope that as I do someone else who has never really known what Christmas means will get to do the same. For this to happen I know I need to make some changes. I need to discover what I have buried; the wonder of God coming to earth looking for "poor, ornery people like you and like I". So as I do this uncovering I think of a place where it is ironically Christmas all year. Christmas carols are sung every day. "Silent Night" is sung for hours by thousands of people. There is a restaurant called "The Christmas Tree" open every day. And get this; the town is less than five percent Christian! The rest of the people are Muslim. The town is of course, BETHLEHEM. It is a noisy place with dusty, narrow, crowded streets bustling with the busyness of life, but Bethlehem is like here too. For all the things that say, "Christmas" the meaning can get lost because the wonder of Jesus is not known.

How can this be uncovered and discovered again? We need to stop. We need to sing, even and especially if we don't think we can. We need to pray. And we need to let Jesus BE our life. We need to let him decorate our lives with who he is: Wonderful Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, and Prince of Peace. Do you know this? Do you need to re-discover what this means? Who do you know who needs to know this?

As we prepare to "Come to Bethlehem and see" these are questions we need to take time to ponder each day in the journey to Christmas. My prayer is that as we do we will begin to make it Christmas all year long. What if, because we did this, someone else came to know Jesus? How about if we made every day of this season a time to recall the words: "How silently, how silently the wondrous gift is given. So God imparts to human hearts the blessing of His heaven. No ear may hear his coming, but in this world of sin, where meek souls will receive him still, the dear Christ enters in."

Let's discover Christmas again. Look through this issue of the Trumpet and find the many ways available and let's be sure someone we know gets the best Christmas ever.







The deacons serve a 3 year term. FPC has divided our lovely city and surrounding areas into 13 zones. Each deacon is in charge of one zone. Besides checking with members in their

respective zones via all types of greeting/bereavement cards, phone calls and visits to shut-ins, the deacons organize and deliver the church flowers, set and clean-up monthly communion and even provide communion to any home bound member. The deacons host two deacon Sunday's a year, provide and arrange the Thanksgiving Sunday, 4th of July BBQ, and provide refreshments or meals at memorial services. They help any member in any and every task they can when called upon. The deacon budget is 100% funded by the church family and not part of the general budget. Nominations for new deacons are being gathered now and I hope you take advantage of this wonderful opportunity to serve.


