From the Pastor's Workshop

"Turning the Corner"

We have just been through celebrating the wonder of Emmanuel; God with us and the gift of God coming to us in Christmas, but the reality is that it is still winter. A carol that we don't sing much we are reminded of our hope in the midst of this waiting time:

In the bleak midwinter, frosty wind made moan Earth stood hard as iron, water like a stone Snow had fallen, snow on snow, snow on snow In the bleak midwinter, long, long ago

God, heaven cannot hold Him nor the earth sustain Heaven and earth shall flee away when He comes to reign In the bleak midwinter a stable place sufficed The Lord God Almighty, Jesus Christ.

With cold and snow and dark still upon us how do we "turn the corner" to the hope of the Gospel? Lent comes early this year. Ash Wednesday is February 10. We begin to make this turn by turning who we are over to Jesus and letting him lead us when we might rather hide out. Turning the corner means doing just the opposite of what we might WANT to do. It might mean turning off a lot of the stuff of life in order to hear the voice of God's Holy Spirit that wants us to come to a new place of knowing God's shaping presence.

This is an invitation to learning. Learning comes from the discipline of listening. But contrary to popular opinion, we can't hear God without turning off the competing sounds and learning to let the directions settle in our souls. How often do I stop to listen to God in his word; to his Holy Spirit speaking in the Bible to how I am engaging life? I know the answer is "not enough". I have lived just long enough to think, "I've done this before" (you know, the seven deadly words) and without asking God what I need to learn THIS time I proceed. That is NOT how to grow or turn a corner.

We are entering a new year. It is time to turn a corner with the awareness that every turn belongs to God; every turn is different and God has something NEW he wants us to learn. May we do this together as we head into Lent; as we approach Easter; as we LET God take us apart and put us back together for his glory. May we be open to being made new in this new year by the surprise of God's grace that makes all things new.



Remember the story in Nehemiah when the wall of Jerusalem needed to be rebuilt? Each man and his household worked toward that goal and the wall was rebuilt in 52 days! What an impact we could have in this community if we continue in the momentum that's been established this Advent /Christmas season.


Randy Frazee writes about this in Believe, Chapter 16. "One of the marked differences between the church and rest of society is the call to live for others." Looking at the new testament churches, they lived in a hostile culture, they banded together, looking out for one another, providing for each others' needs, loving each other with an agape love, praying, meeting and playing together. This was attractive to others who didn't have a faith community in their lives.

So much of what we see happening in our society today boils down to the isolation of the individual and the lack of recognition that humans were created to be in community both with God and others. We cannot expect society to want what we have unless we reach out to invite them in and what they see on the inside of our church community is caring, loving, and concern for others. Individually, it might mean coming alongside a neighbor who is needing someone to listen, or a ride to the doctor's office, or -- you fill in the blank. What each of us needs, in order to fill the need is simple: a caring heart, a listening ear, and wanting to make it better for someone else, letting them decide how far to take it. Pray for that person that God would work in their heart. Pray that our motive is pure as God would have it be. As the Body of Christ, we can support each other in individual efforts and come together for broader reaching efforts. As we see this happen, may we be rejoicing that God is using us and that seeds are being planted. We may never see the harvest, but if we're faithful to do what God has called us to do, He will be faithful to see the work to completion.

So, "let us not become weary in doing good. Let us keep on loving each other as brothers and sisters. Let us not forget to show hospitality to strangers, for by so doing some people have shown hospitality to angels without knowing it. And do not forget to do good and to share with others for with such sacrifices God is pleased." (Galatians 6:9; Hebrews 13: 1-3; 15-16)

PER CAPITA APPORTIONMENT

The 2016 Per Capita Apportionment is \$50: \$35 per member for NV Presbytery and \$15 for ECO.

Per Capita Apportionment is paid each year by all Presbyterian congregations, based on the number of Active Members in the congregation for NV Presbytery and according to the 2016 church budget for ECO. The Nevada Presbytery portion will stay in NV Presbytery ONLY, none will go to General Assembly.

Per Capita is the first major expenditure for First Presbyterian Church each year, this year amounting to \$10,363.50 which includes a 10% discount if we pay our total Per Capita by February 15th. Every member is encouraged to contribute their personal Per Capita Apportionment. If you received a box of offering envelopes there is a blue envelope for your per capita donation. Special Per Capita envelopes are also located in the pews or **mark your check "Per Capita"**.

The **Per Capita Apportionment** for **2016 is \$50** per active member of First Presbyterian; for a family with two active members - husband and wife, Per Capita Apportionment for the family would be \$100 (\$50 x 2).
