# "Leaving Up Christmas"

Will you have a Christmas tree this year? The tree reminds us of God's evergreen faithfulness and that God's greatest gift would die on a cross made from a tree to redeem us. If you are buying a cut tree this year or know someone who is, or if you know an office that has a Christmas tree you have a great new way to find the perfect tree at our very own "tree forest". Youth Pastor Timothy Plummer will be heading up two tree lots and the proceeds will go to mission in the church and community. Our youth will be working in the lots. There will be Christmas music and hot chocolate and coffee and of course, welcome brochures to our services. One lot will be at Carson Lanes and the other will be directly across from the Ormsby House on Carson Street just south of 5th Street.

We are excited about this outreach into the community. Think of how many people buy a tree but don't have a church home. This is a classic approach that takes people back to the basics of Christmas and will lead them to know about "Leaving Up Christmas". This will invite people to know that the gift God gives us at Christmas is for every day of the year. I got the idea when I read about a woman who could not bring herself to put away the manger scene after Christmas. She realized that what she saw in the manger she needed all the time.

This is true for me. Is the same true for you? I think it is for all of us and especially those who don't have a church home. They are longing for the heart of Christmas even though they may not know it, but do you know why most people aren't in church, even at Christmas? It is so simple: no one asked them. We all have lots of friends and neighbors who need to know the gift of Christmas, but no one has asked them to come to the manger; to experience leaving Christmas up all year.

So here is what I want to suggest we do right now; early in December. Make a list of people who we are going to invite to Christmas Eve service and invite them right away. Let them know now that you would like them to come and experience the JOY of the season; the music, the lights, the smells, (Dan Luke's famous peppermint mocha lattes!) Invite people to a good "old fashioned Christmas in a beautiful and warm place; to a place that finds that place in their hearts that needs the touch of God's grace.

It is a wonder-full time that takes us super-naturally to the manger to behold God's amazing grace. It can last all year and forever. So, put on some great Christmas carols right now...they tell the story so well. Listen to the words. Sing along. Write that list; not to Santa, but to



Jesus, about who you will invite to his birthday party. You might invite ten and one comes, but it is in the inviting that God's Holy Spirit has room to work in you and in the person you invite. Just tell them that what happens here is something you know will really matter to them. Tell them it is simple and beautiful and that you don't want them to miss it. Maybe you've had a loss or a hard year. It is when this is so that people most listen to what we have to say about hope. So let's "decorate for Christmas" in a way that shows the "light that shines in the darkness" so that "the people who walk in darkness may see a great light." THEY will be glad we did and so will you.
