From the Pastor's Workshop

"Giving Away What God Put in Us"

I love the fall. I think most of us do for so many reasons. It seems a time for reflecting on where we have been. We can find ourselves in the closets of our minds where there is stuff we had forgotten we had. Give the junk to the devil and the gold to God!

My point is that in Jesus Christ we are new creations. Yes, there is junk from the past, but it is past. Those experiences have helped to make us who we are, but most of all we have been made new by Jesus Christ. As these new creations we are free to give away who we are in Christ. We get to show the world the freedom that comes from living as people who have been in the words of a hymn, "ransomed, healed, restored, and forgiven." We are in Paul's words, "God's handiwork; literally God's poem."

One of my great joys is getting to see this in person as I watch people giving away what God has placed in them so that others may see Jesus. It happens all the time as I look around at people like Kaye and Duane Glanzmann leading a Sunday morning class and as I see the glorious ways Kaye has decorated and given bloom throughout the church to our "Believe" theme. I see it in Ken and Vickie Pearson doing...well, what DON'T they do? Or how about that youngster Kaye Keeton buzzing about as the "perpetual deacon" taking cheer to people? I could go on and on naming names and I mention just a few to give examples of how this congregation flourishes and people are coming to know Jesus as Lord because you all are "giving away what God has put in us".

The joy of being servants stewards who give sacrificially without worrying about what we don't have is what God desires for us. This is what Jesus showed us in giving himself away for us. He did not worry about what it would cost him. He did not fret about what he wouldn't get to do. And as those who follow him neither will we as we accept that we can't out give God.

This is what we are learning to live in our *Believe* series. In this month of considering what God wants to use of what he has given us my prayer is that we would become joyful stewards so that people who don't have the joy of Jesus Christ would be compelled by the servant stewardship he has placed in us. Of course we have a financial budget to meet in order to do the mission Christ has set before us, but when we realize God has already written THE CHECK that really matters we find that we are free to let go of the stuff of this world and live by giving away what he has given us for his glory.

On November 22 we will have ONE SERVICE at 10 AM, followed by a Thanksgiving meal. We will dedicate our pledges at that time. If you have not brought yours in before, please bring it that day so that together we may

celebrate "giving away what God has placed in us." My prayer is that we would do this with the faith that one day we will meet people in heaven we may have never met here who walk up to us and say, "Thank you for being so generous. Because you were I got to meet Jesus."



Big Idea: Because God has forgiven me, I can forgive others.



Stewardship and Commitment -

This month we will learn more about stewardship in the Church. We will study it as part of our Believe series. Stewardship is about how we manage all our time, talent and treasure. Where God has gifted us with a talent or the time to help, we should be doing just that. Do you have a visual art gift or can you make a great cup of coffee? Are you someone with organizational talents or do you have a desire to see clean windows? There are hundreds, maybe thousands of ways that each of us can impact the mission of Jesus Christ in this church family. Ask God to use you where He needs you, and then ask someone "where can I be of service?"

Maybe it's time to make time to bring our talent, time and treasure to God FIRST, so that He can do with it what HE wills and not what we have on our agenda. I have to remember to surrender my agenda to Jesus, otherwise I am overwhelmed by all the things I "have to do". When I let Him order my world, all the important things get done and I have peace. On the other hand, when I become overcommitted to "good things" and "worthy causes", and leave behind the opportunity to spend time doing something for Jesus, the Church suffers. It's not quite the New Year yet, but I am going to resolve to do more things in the company of Jesus and in the company of my church family. Hope to see you there!

CHURCH STAFF - WHO DOES WHAT?

Have you ever wanted to know what the various duties are of your church staff? Well here is a general description of each staff person and brief description of their duties:

Pastor Bruce Kochsmeier – Preaches the Word on Sunday, teaches Bible study on Wednesday, home and hospital visits, responds to numerous phone requests, repairs toilets/sinks, etc. etc.

Karen Dahlen, Director of Music Ministries – Coordinates all music for Sunday worship services which includes the Praise Team, Chancel Choir, Men Chorus, and Women's Choir, special musicians. Plays for memorial services and other services as requested.

Timothy Plummer, Director of Youth Ministries – Coordinates all activities for our youth from 6th grade to 12th grade which includes weekly Bible study time and fun meetings, camps and mission projects.

Nancy Kochsmeier, Director of Children's Ministries – Coordinates all activities for our children who are four years old to 5th grade. The activities include weekly Sunday school, annual Vacation Bible Experience in the summer and special programs at Christmas.

Deana Ercanbrack, Director of Nursery – Coordinates 2 nursery workers in the care of our infants to 3 years of age. Schedules care for children during any church activity.

Dawn Berger, Communications Coordinator – Produces our weekly Sunday bulletin, monthly Trumpet and brochures as needed for Stewardship, special seasons and activities. Maintains our web site, www.fpccarsoncity.org. Check it out if you have not.

Bob Stroh, Finance/Payroll/HR – Pays all of the church bills and makes sure our outstanding staff receives their pay checks on time. Produces all session reports and oversees the church budget. Orders supplies for the office and others as needed. Negotiates contracts as needed.

Charlene Rodman, Office Manager, Membership/Donations – Coordinates all membership/visitor information entry into our Church Windows program, prints directories, reports for deacons and other committees. Coordinates our donation volunteers and reports. And anything else that comes her way.
