From the Pastor's Workshop

"Instructions that Make Sense"

If you have ever tried to put something together by reading the instructions you know why most of us are hesitant to start there. Often the writing is so poor that the result is not at all what we had hoped for. The bicycle looks like a swing set; the computer never works and locks us out, the TV won't even turn on. You know what this is like.

We live in a biblically illiterate culture in which many have never opened a Bible because they don't think they will understand it. They have prejudged the Bible because they have never had someone explain it or LIVE IT. I believe all our hurts relate back to not knowing and understanding the Bible, for as we learned in "The Story" God's plan is to get us back to himself.

Now we have opportunity to discover what it means to be a people who know who God is, what we should do about it, and how we become people whose entire way of living is a reflection of the love God has shown for us in Jesus Christ.

The "Believe" series calls us into understanding God's instructions for our lives, not as a set of rules to hold us back, but to set us free. When we know who God is we know how he has loved us and what it means for all of our days...and for all of our dark times. This series invites us for 30 weeks into places we may have never gone because we never knew they existed. These are places of understanding ourselves and how God's love reaches out to make us whole as nothing we have ever tried possibly could.

You will notice that the symbol for "Believe" is a key with a cross cut into it. The key to knowing God comes from learning how the cross makes sense of everything and unlocks doors that we never have been through before; doors that enable us to experience the fruit of God's Spirit: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, gentleness and self-control. These are keys that only Jesus can give in the power of the Holy Spirit. They are keys we will only understand as we grow together into fitting them into the locks of our lives.

This will happen as we worship, pray, and study together on Sundays and on Wednesdays. It will happen as we learn as never before why we believe what we believe, both in our heads AND in our hearts. As this happens things will change. We will see life differently and the world will see us differently. There will be a hope in us and about us that will take us to places and people we never knew we needed to engage and visit. And these keys will open locks that truly will, like the chorus says, "...will cause the things of this world to grow strangely dim, in the light of HIS glory and grace."

We all need this in our lives and the world around us needs this. My prayer is that this series will be the highest priority in all of our lives and that we will invite others to experience the promises of Bible they have never made their own.



BUDGET PLANNING FOR 2016

Each Fall we evaluate our financial results for the current year and we have to do our planning for the new year, which is just around the corner. THE CHURCH OR ISOLATION?

In speaking with a friend a few days ago, I realized how easy it is to isolate oneself. The friend is living in a city and basically goes to work and comes home every day, but doesn't interact with folks much other than flatmates and co-workers. This kind of life can be so stifling to the soul. The trouble for my friend is that he doesn't really understand or know where to turn to get out of being stuck in this rut. My friend has a heart for helping others, but doesn't get involved in the outreach that make things better for someone else, because he is not part of a community that does outreach. It is a frustrating dilemma.

On one hand, we are created to be in communion with God in a one-on-one relationship (the vertical relationship). The trouble is, when that is the only way we approach God, we get a very small picture of how He works. We are designed to commune with each other in Jesus name (the horizontal relationship). It is not just about me or you and God, but about me and you as we approach God together. God works within us, but also works on us as we live and work in community with others. This is the reason we are to seek a worshipping church community in order to continue growth beyond our personal relationship with Christ. A church community is supposed to care for each person within it, to worship and glorify God/Christ/Holy Spirit together and to demonstrate to onlookers from outside and within Christ's love for each other. This will build each member up and strengthen the fellowship. We become a cord of many strands, not easily broken. There are many folks who feel that they have been betrayed by the church in some way, because the love was not shown, or they didn't understand how the body of Christ (the church) is supposed to function. Perhaps you have experienced this. The church is not made up of perfect people, but of people in need of Jesus' love and acceptance. It is a hospital for sinners who are being transformed into saints.

Acts 2:42 talks about the new Christians at Pentecost devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship and to the breaking of bread and prayer. Hebrews 10:25 tells Christians to not give up meeting together, but to encourage each other in assembling together. Iron sharpens iron - we grow together in the Body of Christ when we fellowship and worship corporately. We are being honed and shaped by the experience of striving toward the goal of knowing Jesus together. This is God's plan for His people. I will continue praying for my friend to find a Gospel preaching, church home.




