

# 1 SAMUEL 2:1-10

2 And Hannah prayed and said,

"My heart exults in the LORD; my horn is exalted in the LORD. My mouth derides my enemies, because I rejoice in your salvation. <sup>2</sup> "There is none holy like the LORD: for there is none besides you; there is no rock like our God. <sup>3</sup>Talk no more so very proudly, let not arrogance come from your mouth; for the LORD is a God of knowledge, and by him actions are weighed. <sup>4</sup>The bows of the mighty are broken, but the feeble bind on strength. <sup>5</sup>Those who were full have hired themselves out for bread, but those who were hungry have ceased to hunger. ### MARK 7:24-30


