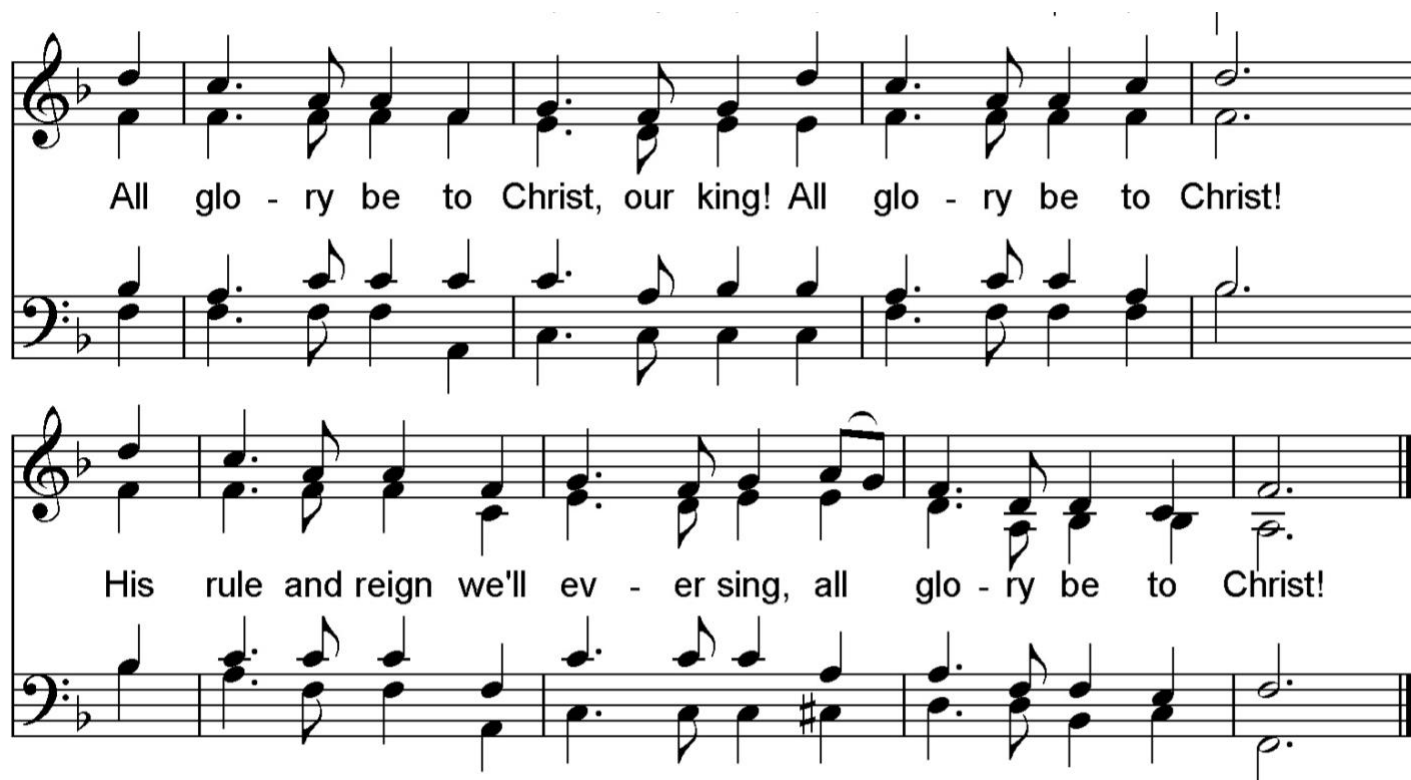



ISAIAH 55:1-3


“Come, everyone who thirsts,

### AMOS 8:4-14

- 4 Hear this, you who trample on the needy
