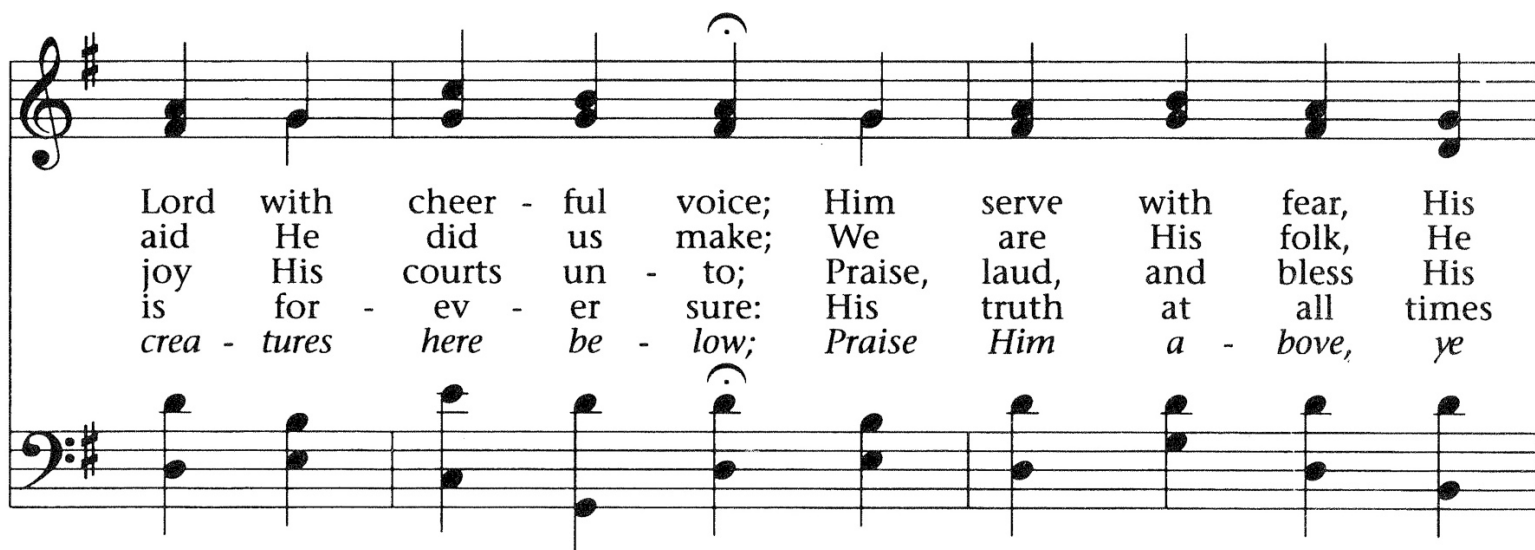

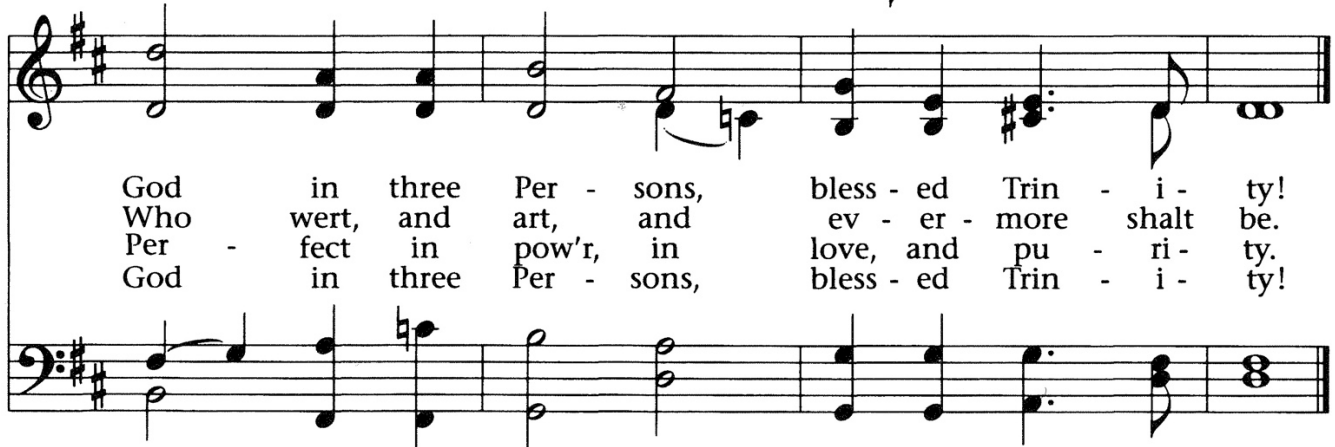

GENESIS 6:1-8

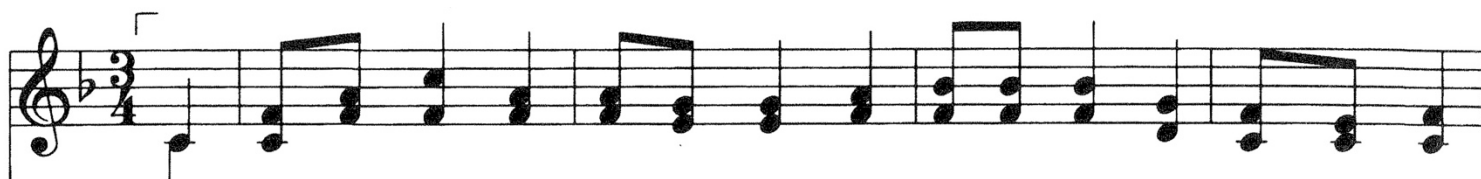

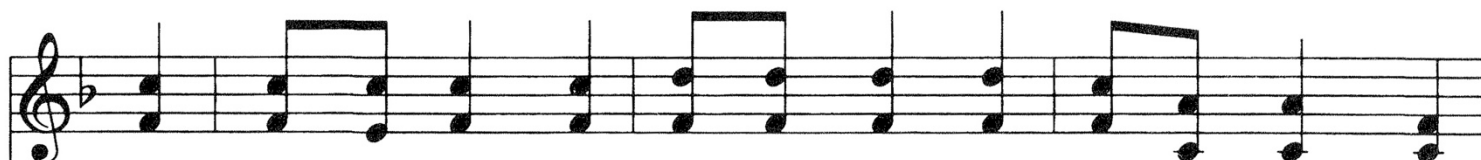

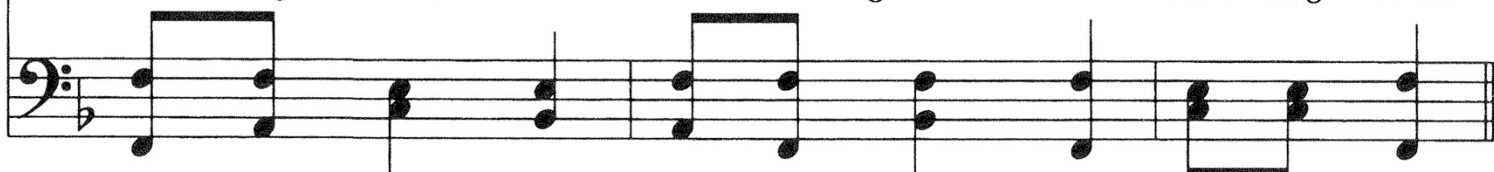
