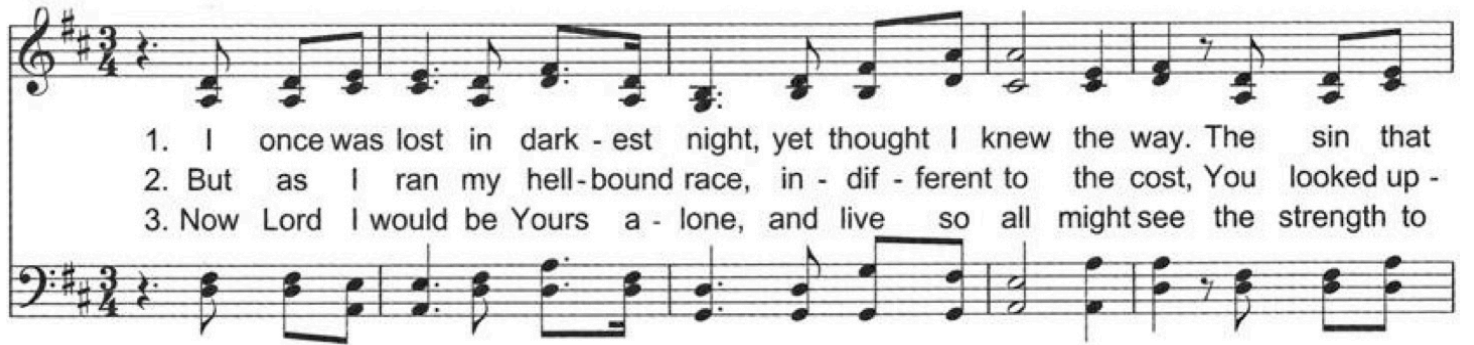
KNOWING JOY

PHILIPPIANS 1:18B-26

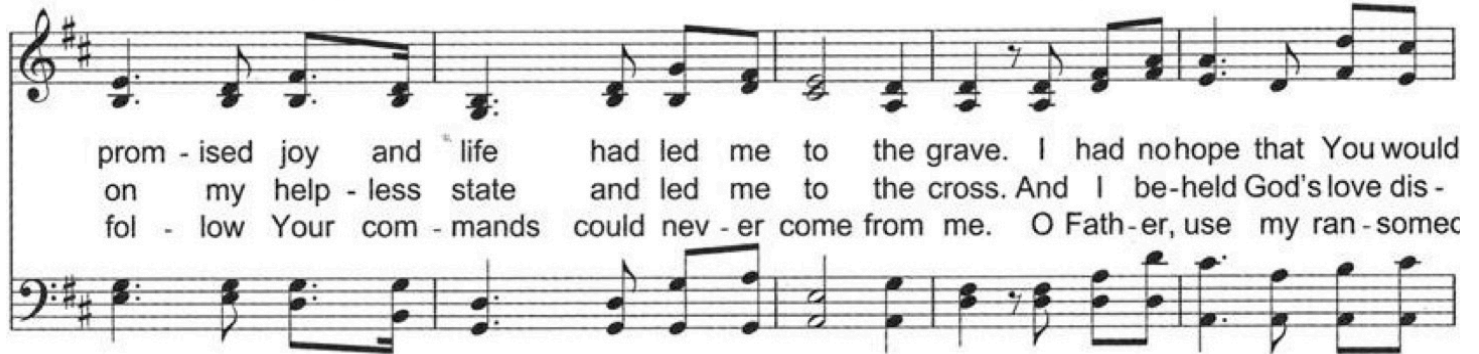

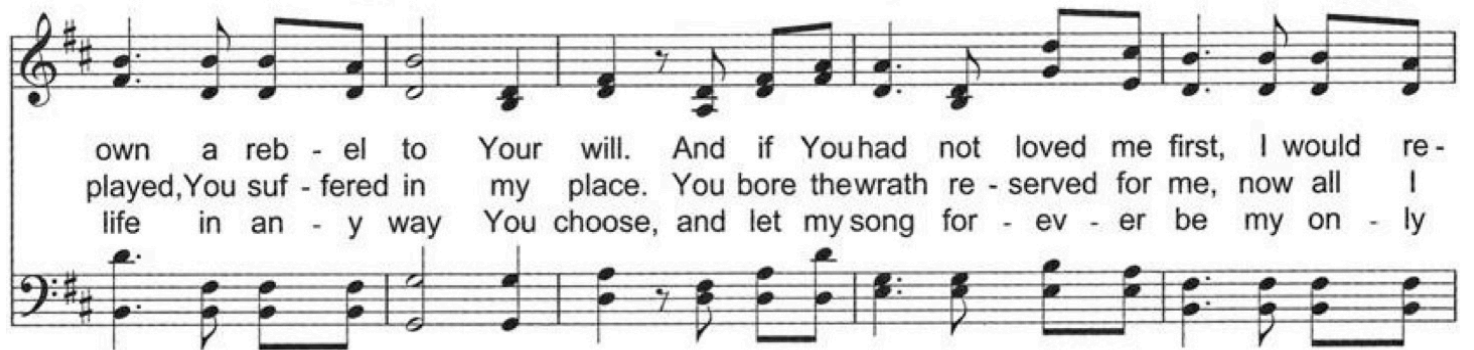

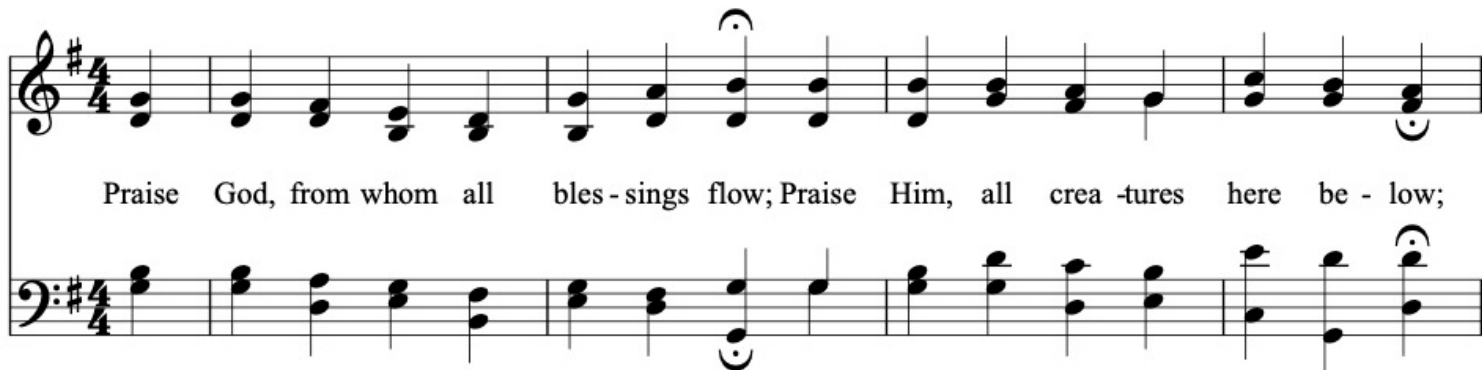
