THE OPPORTUNITY

Frontline Church is a thriving multi-site church looking for a Director of College Ministry to help pioneer an initiative to integrate college students into the local church.

Founded in a living room in 2005, Frontline Church has grown to 2,000 members and five congregations across central Oklahoma with plans to plant more churches in the coming years. The mission of Frontline Church is to multiply gospel communities that love God, love people, and push back darkness. We seek to unite our historic Christian faith through the beauty of contemporary and traditional liturgy which has produced a growing, vibrant church that is changing lives and having real impact in the city.

THE COMMUNITY

Oklahoma City has a thriving culture with numerous attractions such as great restaurants, concert venues, farmers' markets, and vibrant coffee houses. Oklahoma City is marked by a low cost of living with the amenities and excitement of a healthy, growing city attracting many young adults.

THE ROLE

In a moment when young adults are desperately struggling due to a lack of direction, depth, and resilience, Frontline Church desires to cultivate a movement of college students through integrated spiritual formation to withstand and lead through the current winds of early adulthood. Frontline has nurtured strong partnerships with impactful parachurch ministries at local universities and seeks to more intentionally come alongside these ministries to support the development of college students into resilient, life-long followers of Christ. We believe this is a vital need and must be met by the local church. With over 100,000 college students in the OKC metro, we believe that by partnering with local parachurch ministries across our five congregations, we can see the next generation of strong, wise, Christ-followers cultivated in the church.



The Associate Director of College Ministry will work within the Community and Mission team based out of Frontline's flagship congregation in Downtown Oklahoma City. They will serve alongside the Director of College Ministry to strengthen relationships of trust with local parachurch ministries. They will be responsible for creating an impactful monthly experience that will serve college students seeking to deepen their faith. They will cultivate teams of volunteers across our congregations to serve college students at their local campuses and integrate them into the intergenerational ministry of the church and leadership development opportunities.

QUALIFICATIONS AND CHARACTERISTICS

- Experience in college ministry, young adult ministry, or parachurch ministry preferred.
- Spiritually mature with high character and a deep dependence on both the Word and Spirit of God.
- Must agree with Frontline Church's doctrinal statement.

JOB DUTIES

- Building and maintaining meaningful relationships with directors of other campus ministry organizations.
- Working on a team to plan, and organize a monthly gathering of college students from across all 5 congregations. This gathering will incorporate worship, teaching, and fun elements while being supported by the various leaders from our leadership community.
- Creating systems to build and maintain college ministry teams at multiple Frontline congregations.
- Manage various administrative tasks (e.g. event planning and budgets)
- Ability to lead related initiatives such as gathering events, retreats, etc.
- Serving within a ministry team to accomplish the mission of the church on Sundays and during the week.
