We seek to unite our historic Christian faith through the beauty of contemporary worship and traditional liturgy, which has produced a growing, vibrant church that is changing lives and having a real impact in the city.

THE ROLE

We are looking for a visionary leader who is passionate about spiritual formation and theological development. The Associate Pastor will play a pivotal role in our church as we seek to meet the growing needs of catechesis, theological development, and biblical literacy. The Associate Pastor will lead the development and oversight of our class offerings, which complement the formative work God does in Frontline on Sundays and between Sundays in Community Groups.

By overseeing our Connections Director, the Associate Pastor will guide newcomers as they journey toward membership, in which classes play a key role. By overseeing our Facilities Director, the Associate Pastor will ensure our physical space reflects our spiritual values of hospitality, beauty, and order, creating an environment where people feel welcomed and cared for.

This role will have plenty of teaching, discipleship, and pastoral care opportunities, shared in collaboration with our broader pastoral team.

- Provide strategic oversight of the Connection Director in the leadership and development of all Sunday Connections teams. Ensure effective execution of visitor follow-up processes and help attenders and members engage in community groups, service opportunities, and membership.
- Oversee the Facilities Director to ensure proper care, use, and stewardship of the facilities.
- Serve as a part of our ministry team by praying for, leading, shepherding, mentoring, and providing pastoral counsel to serve the people of Frontline Downtown, meeting additional needs as they arise on Sundays and during the week.
