

Luke 22:42

- The Lord calls the <u>wife</u> to uniquely "iconize" the Church's response to Christ in their marriage.
 - ► So what is the Bible NOT teaching?
 - It can't mean that women are lower than men.
 - No one is forced into submission, not by the church nor by anyone's spouse. It also does not mean that a wife is expected to live in a micro managed kind of life.

- The Lord calls the <u>wife</u> to uniquely "iconize" the Church's response to Christ in their marriage.
 - ► What this does mean?
 - That a wife voluntarily yields to her husbands leadership as an act of worship to King Jesus.


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Ephesians 5:22

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 - ► What this does mean?
 - That a wife voluntarily yields to her husbands leadership as an act of worship to King Jesus.
 - The motivation for a wife submitting to her husband is worship to Jesus, just as the Man's sacrifice for his wife is worship to king Jesus.

"In a march, on person sets the tempo with the baton and everyone falls into lockstep. In the marital dance, however, the husband leads as he listens to the music of Christ. Because the wife hears the same music, they're able to keep time in their own minds and move as one."
