### *Confronting Life-Dominating Sin*



A little bit of sin is like a little bit of arsenic in your breakfast; it's not going to be well with you. Like poison, sin is deadly even in the smallest quantities but unlike poison, sin is enslaving. It conquers more and more of the individual until it dominates and infects every aspect of life. How does a counselor recognize that the sin is "life-dominating"? How do you counsel a person whose life is dominated by a particular sin? In this session, we will look at the topic of life-dominating sins: what are they and how can they be overcome?

### *Evaluating True Repentance*

Repentance is part of the Christian life. The Bible teaches that there are two kinds of repentance, one is genuine and the other is not. In counseling, it is often difficult to discern if the counselee is truly repentant, or merely sorry. In this session we will discuss the nature and character of true repentance and then formulate a process of determining where our counselee stands.
