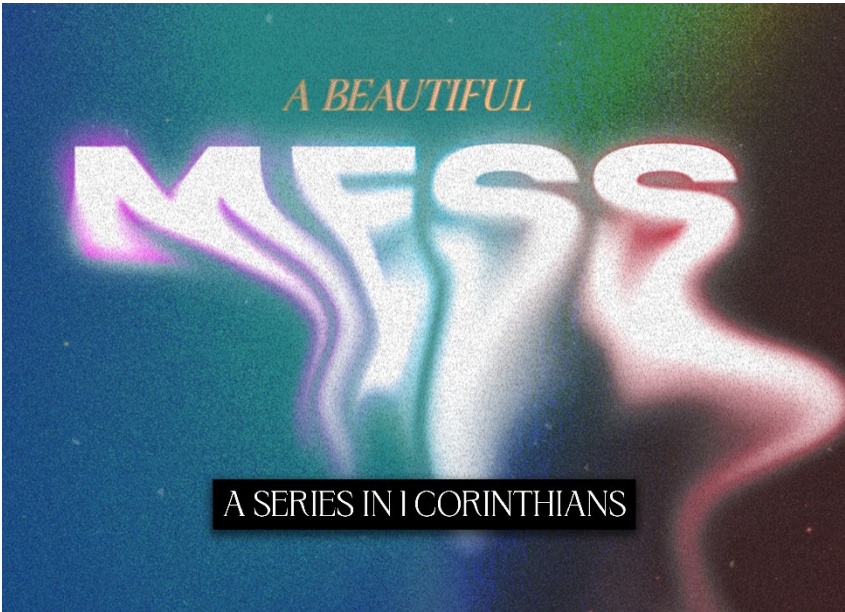

Weekly Prayer:
