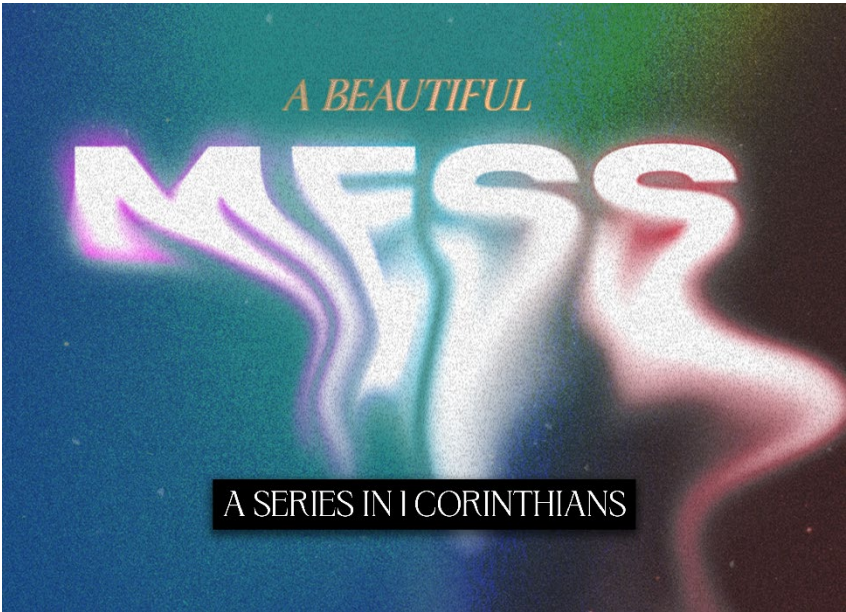

Weekly Prayer:

Pray for our church-This week we are praying for our own personal and corporate commitment to holiness.
