Weekly Prayer:

Pray for our church-This week we are praying that our pastors would be faithful to follow the command of 2 Timothy 2:2, which says, "What you have heard from me in the presence of many witnesses, commit to faithful men who will be able to teach others also." Pray that our church would see the value of this work and commit ourselves to it. Pray that men would be raised up as examples of obedience to the Lord and as teachers of His Word. Pray we would see the fruit of this in our church. Pray we would be able to send out men to churches in Panama City, around the country, and around the world.

Pray for a church-This week, we are praying for Chapel at the Beach in Rosemary Beach. Pray for their pastor, Cole Floyd, and his wife, Christina, as they raise 4 kids under 5. Pray as their church enters the Spring Break season as they have the opportunity to minister to families for short seasons. Pray that their church's desire and effectiveness in discipleship would grow.

Pray for the Church-This week we are praying for Christians living in Qatar. While it is illegal to be a Qatari Christian, over half of the resident population is from outside of Qatar. Pray that Christian foreigners would have success sharing the Gospel with Qataris. Pray that foreigners would hear the Gospel, be saved, and take the Gospel back to their home countries, many of whom are as needy as Qatar. Pray for the underground church in this country.
